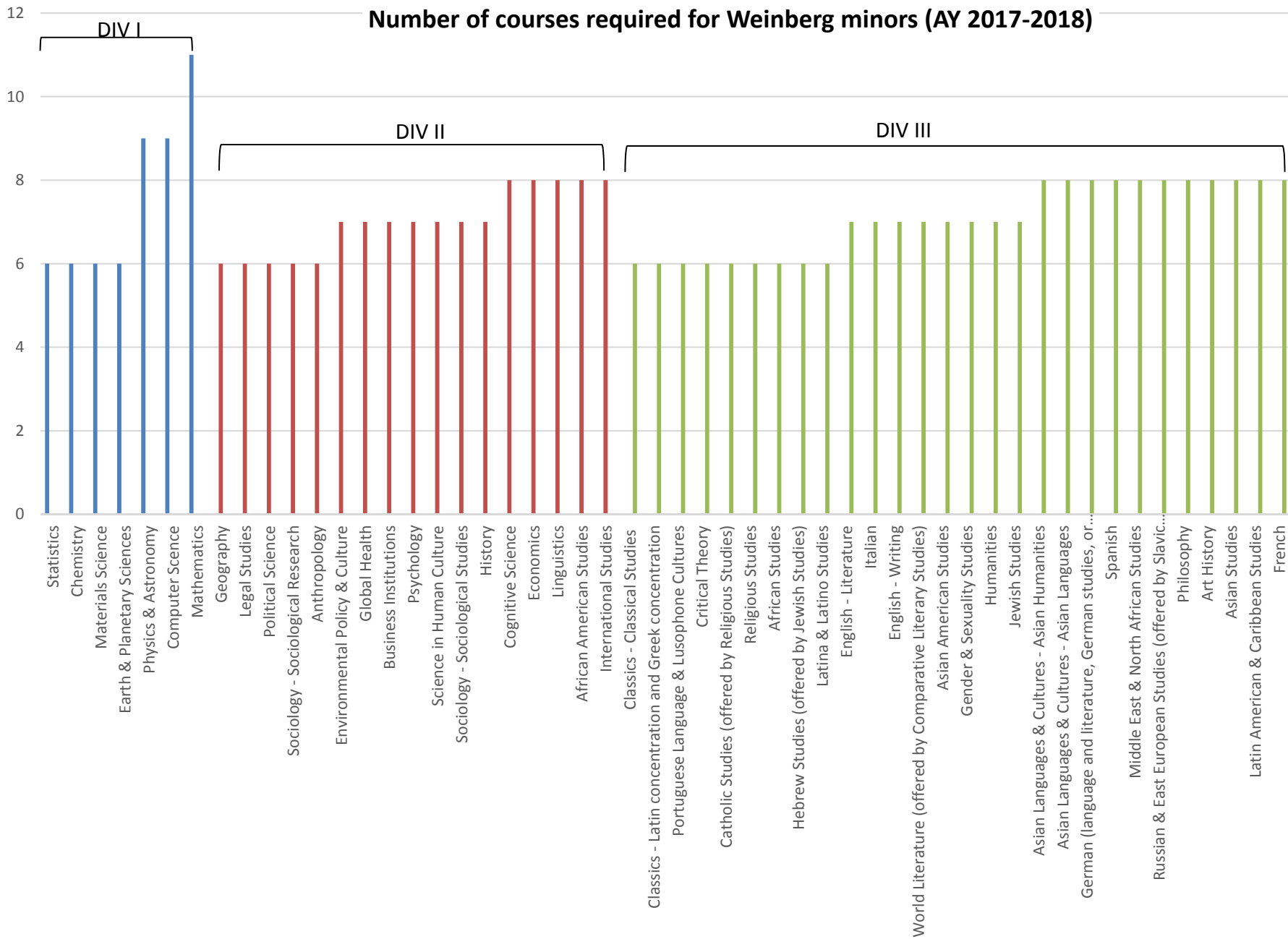


Number of courses required for Weinberg minors (AY 2017-2018)



Total courses required for Weinberg minors (from 2017-18 Undergraduate Catalog)

- * Counts assume students have no AP/IB credits.
- * If either MATH 220 & 224 or MATH 212, 213, & 214 is required, this is counted as 2 courses.
- * Separately credited science labs are not included in the unit totals.
- * Counts for language & literature majors omit foreign language prereqs; these are indicated in the notes, as are some other prerequisites.
- * Four "ex-certificate" minors still require that 5 courses must not be double-counted toward a major (indicated in notes). No other minors allow double-counting.

Asian Studies	8	Students with two years of study of an Asian language need only 6 courses (Native-speaker proficiency does not reduce the number of courses needed)
Business Institutions	7	4 prerequisite courses (in economics, calculus, and statistics) are also required.
Catholic Studies (offered by Religious Studies)	6	
Chemistry	6	Any one of the general chemistry sequences (3 options) is a prerequisite.
Classics - Latin concentration and Greek concentration	6	The third quarter of first-year language or equivalent is a prerequisite.
Classics - Classical Studies	6	
Cognitive Science	8	
Computer Science	9	Also requires 4 math courses as prerequisites.
Critical Theory	6	
Earth & Planetary Sciences	6	Also requires at least 2 calculus courses, 1 physics course, and 1 chem course as prerequisites for required coursework. Some students may need more math/physics/chem depending on course selection.
Economics	8	Also, 1 calculus course and 1 statistics course are prerequisites for required coursework.

French	8	First- and second-year language courses do not count toward the minor; thus, completion of a full-year of second year language, or equivalent, is a prerequisite.
Gender & Sexuality Studies	7	
Geography	6	Also requires 2 calculus courses and 1 statistics course as prerequisites.

German (language and literature, German studies, or business German)	8	Full year of second-year language or equivalent is a prerequisite.
Global Health	7	Also requires public health experience abroad.
Hebrew Studies (offered by Jewish Studies)	6	Full year of second-year language or equivalent is a prerequisite.

Italian	7	First- and second-year language courses do not count toward the minor; thus, completion of a full-year of second year language, or equivalent, is a prerequisite.
Jewish Studies	7	Full year of second-year language or equivalent is a prerequisite. <i>5 courses must not be double-counted toward a major.</i>
Latin American & Caribbean Studies	8	<i>5 courses must not be double-counted toward a major.</i>

Middle East & North African Studies	8	Students with two years of study of a Middle East or North African language need only 6 courses (Native-speaker proficiency does not reduce the number of courses needed)

Physics & Astronomy	9	Also requires 5 additional math and science courses.

Portuguese Language & Lusophone Cultures	6	Full year of second-year language or equivalent is a prerequisite.

Russian & East European Studies (offered by Slavic Languages & Literatures)	8	This represents the requirements for a revised and renamed minor, effective in Fall 2016.
Science in Human Culture	7	<i>5 courses must not be double-counted toward a major.</i>
Sociology - Sociological Research	6

Spanish	8	Prerequisite is "SPANISH 201, AP credit, or placement by the online Spanish Language Placement exam," implying proficiency at least equivalent to completion of a full year of second-year language courses.
Statistics	6	5 math courses are also required.
